NOTE: In comparing the unit and outlay estimates in this justification with those shown in the fiscal year 2002 justification for Housing Payments, it should be noted that the fiscal year 2003 totals <a href="include">include</a> estimates for the Section 202/811 program, while that program was specifically <a href="excluded">excluded</a> in prior years. Consequently, the totals shown for Housing Payments in this justification are significantly higher than in the past. Also, fiscal year 2001 actual outlays were approximately \$128 million (excluding Housing for Special Population outlays) below the estimate contained in last year's budget. Those disbursements are now assumed to occur in fiscal year 2002.
