## Summary Statement

No new obligations are anticipated in fiscal year 2007.

The Flexible Subsidy Fund was initially authorized by the Housing and Community Development Amendments of 1978, subsequently amended by the Housing and Community Development (HCD) Act of 1987, and further amended by the McKinney Homeless Assistance Amendments Act of 1988. The HCD Amendments of 1978 established the Flexible Subsidy Fund into which repaid funds would be credited along with any transfer from the Rental Housing Assistance Fund.

Refunding of excess rental income remitted to the Department could be made from either the Rental Housing Assistance Fund or the Flexible Subsidy Fund, as authorized by Section 532 of the fiscal year 2000 Appropriations Act and amended by Section 861 of the American Homeownership and Economic Opportunity Act of 2000. Excess rental income in the Rental Housing Assistance Fund not refunded to project owners will continue to be transferred to the Flexible Subsidy Fund.

The unobligated balance remaining in this account in fiscal year 2007 will consist of excess rental income, interest and principal on loans, and interest on investments. However, none of these funds are available for obligation without Congressional appropriations.

### Initiatives

No new initiatives are proposed for fiscal year 2007.

[From the Rental Housing Assistance Fund, all uncommitted balances of excess rental charges as of September 30, 2005, and any collections made during fiscal year 2006 and all subsequent years, shall be transferred to the Flexible Subsidy Fund, as authorized by section 236(g) of the National Housing Act, as amended.] (Departments of Transportation, Treasury, Housing and Urban Development, the Judiciary, the District of Columbia and Independent Agencies Appropriations Act, 2006)

### Explanation of Changes

The fiscal year 2006 Appropriations Act provided permanent authority to transfer any collections of excess rental charges to the Flexible Subsidy Fund. No additional appropriations language is necessary.
