Summary Statement

No new funds are requested for the Housing Certificate Fund in fiscal year 2008. In fiscal year 2005, Congress established two new accounts, Tenant-Based Rental Assistance and Project-Based Rental Assistance, to administer the activities of the Housing Certificate Fund.

This account reflects the rescission of prior year balances. The estimated rescission for 2007 (based on a full-year continuing resolution) is \$2.05 billion. The fiscal year 2007 President's request reflected a rescission of \$2.0 billion. For 2008, the Department requests a rescission of \$1.3 billion.

Initiatives

No new initiatives are proposed for this account.

Proposed Actions

The need for Section 8 amendment funds results from insufficient funds provided for long-term project-based contracts funded primarily in the 1970's and 1980's. During those years, the Department provided contracts that were for terms of up to 40 years. Estimating funding needs over such a long period of time proved to be problematic, and, as a result, many of these Section 8 contracts were inadequately funded. The current practice of renewing expiring contracts for a 1-year term helps to ensure that the problem of inadequately funded contracts is not repeated. However, older long-term contracts that have not reached their termination dates and have not entered the 1-year renewal cycle must be provided amendment funds for the projects to remain financially viable and thus maintain the inventory of affordable rental housing.

In fiscal year 2008, HUD requests no new additional funds for Section 8 Amendments. However, though HUD does not request new budget authority for this activity, the Department plans to continue making Section 8 Amendment obligations as necessary using carryover and recaptured funds. These obligations typically average \$300 million a year.

The 2008 President's budget proposes the following appropriations language:

Of the unobligated balances, including recaptures and carryover, remaining from funds appropriated to the Department of Housing and Urban Development under this heading, the heading ``Annual contributions for assisted housing'', the heading ``Tenant-based rental assistance'', and the heading ``Project-based rental assistance'', for fiscal year 2007 and prior years, \$1,300,000,000 is cancelled, to be effected by the Secretary no later than September 30, 2008: Provided, That, if insufficient funds exist under these headings, the remaining balance may be derived from any other heading under this title: Provided further, That any such balances governed by reallocation provisions under the statute authorizing the program for which the funds were originally appropriated shall be available for the cancellation: Provided further, That any obligated balances of contract authority from fiscal year 1974 and prior that have been terminated shall be cancelled.
