PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS: As part of its comprehensive economic development plan the City of Port Townsend will receive \$500,000 BEDI funds and \$1 million Section 108 Loan funds for a project known as Northwest Maritime Center. The funds will be used for land acquisition, clean-up and redevelop of the Thomas Oil Property which is located in the National Historic District. This project will become a year around educational and tourist attraction that will also provide at least 35 new jobs. When the Center opens there will be classrooms, conference facilities, maritime offices, museums display areas, retail shops, dock for historic vessels, and access to water. The educational and vocational programs will highlight boat building skills, marine trades as well as native crafts.
