PPEP Microbusiness and Housing Development Corporation in Tucson, Arizona will receive a Rural Housing and Economic Development grant in the amount of \$400,000. This innovative award will assist in providing economic development assistance to retain and expand existing small businesses and micro-enterprises in need of enhancing their technological and communication capabilities. These businesses are located in the Colonias areas of Arizona along the US-Mexico border which is also known as the Arizona Border Region Enterprise Community. Over the first two years, the Organization will provide 70 low interest SBA/Micro Loans to businesses for working capital, equipment and inventory. It is anticipated that economic stability will contribute to the creation or retention of at 235 jobs and will enhance local residents access to products and services. Leveraging for this Project total \$690,000. Partners in this Project include: the Small Business Administration, Wells Fargo Bank, U.S. Treasury Department, University of Arizona, Santa Cruz Community College, Bank One and the State of Arizona.

This capacity building grant will assist in the Tribe's ability to provide affordable housing on the Yavapai-Apache Reservation by continuing to expand its existing energy program. The Tribe is an applicant for low cost federal hydropower that will be available in 2004. This low cost energy resource will decrease energy cost on the reservation as well as create jobs and increase economic development on the Reservation. Leveraging for this grant totals \$75,000.
