This support for innovative housing and economic development activities grant will be used for a business incubator, contractor development program, feasibility study for a financial institution, and development and operation of a credit union on the Fort Belknap Indian Reservation. These efforts will result in the creation of 4 new businesses per year. Local and private resources have been leveraged in an amount of \$175,446.
