Denver, Colorado

The City and County of Denver will be awarded \$1,237,725. The Denver Lead Hazard Control Program will control lead hazards in 105 units enrolled through various means including low-income homeowner and rental rehab programs, EBL referrals, and owners of low-income rental properties. Partners in the program include the Colorado Department of Public Health and education and outreach (CDPHE), Denver Environmental Health, Denver Health, Denver Urban Renewal Authority, and Sun Power Weatherization Agency. The program will provide services in older, lower-income neighborhoods in Denver. The program is also proposing to assist CDPHE in addressing lead hazards in homes of children with elevated blood lead levels in Colorado's rural areas outside of Denver.

The City and County of Denver have committed \$293,908 in local matching funds.
