The City of Marshalltown will be awarded a \$1,999,388 grant for Lead Hazard Control. The City of Marshalltown, in cooperation with Marshall County and the Ease Central Iowa Child Lead Poisoning Prevention Program (CLPPP) will cooperate to begin the primary prevention activities that will reduce the lead hazards in homes of low and very low-income families whose children suffer from lead poisoning and provide protection of children from becoming lead poisoned.

This partnership of city, county and regional organizations includes Primary Health Care, Inc. the Marshalltown Medical and Surgical Center. Other participants from the private sector, government, community non-profit, grass roots and faith-based organizations will cooperate with providing referrals and assisting with dissemination of public information about the lead hazard control program and training opportunities that are being offered. The City intends on providing lead hazard control intervention services in approximately 150 privately owned housing units within targeted census tracts where the majority of the older deteriorating housing exists.

The City of Marshalltown will provide \$622,759 in local matching funds.
