Louisville, Kentucky

The City of Louisville will be awarded \$1,944,513. The City created the “Lead Safe Louisville” project to increase access to lead safe housing and further fair housing opportunities. The grant will target 250 units for lead hazard control in six neighborhoods- Portland, Shawnee, Russell, Shelby Park, Smoketown, and Phoenix Hill. Lead Safe Louisville, administered by the City’s Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD), will build upon the success of the City’s past grant in treating 50 units. DHCD will use a three-part strategy to boost production, utilizing methods from low-level interventions to larger scale rehabilitation with lead hazard abatement. Partners include the Jefferson County Health Department, Lead Safe Neighborhood Project, Portland Neighborhood House, JUSTUS, WE CARE about our Community, Inc., the Neighborhood Development Corporation, the Housing Authority of Jefferson County, and others.

The City of Louisville will provide \$597,613 in matching funds.
