**Where to register as a first time user of electronic submission:**

- ❖ Register with the Central Contractor Registrant (CCR) at [www.ccr.gov](http://www.ccr.gov) - just follow the prompts. You need a DUNS number before you do this.

**Where to fax supporting documents requested by the NOFA:**

- ❖ 1-800-483-1010 - do not fax to your Area ONAP. You must use HUD-96011, Facsimile Transmittal cover page. DO NOT use your own cover page. The Facsimile Transmittal cover sheet should be filled out with your application at Grants.gov – the system will automatically give your fax a grant number that will link it with the grant number assigned to your application.
