Notice of Technical Correction to the Notice of Funding Availability for Section 3 Program Coordination and Implementation; Technical Correction

AGENCY: Office of Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity

ACTION: Notice of Technical Correction to the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for HUD's Fiscal Year (FY) 2010 Section 3 Program Coordination and Implementation

SUMMARY: On June 7, 2011, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) posted the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for FY2010 Section 3 Program Coordination and Implementation. Pages 19-20 of the NOFA application describe the HUD Policy Priorities activities/outputs and outcomes that must be included in the Logic Model (HUD 96010) submissions of potential applicants. It was recently brought to our attention that the Logic Model for this NOFA does not contain the specific activities/outputs or outcomes listed on pages 19-20 of the application. To address this matter, applicants for funds under the Section 3 Program Coordination and Implementation NOFA must include at least two of the following **Policy Priority activities/outputs** and the related required **outcomes** in their Logic Models.

As a result, of these amendments, HUD is extending the deadline for the submission of applications to **August 1, 2011**.

DATES: The application deadline date is **August 1, 2011**.

Following selection, but prior to award, HUD staff will be available to assist in clarifying or confirming information that is a prerequisite to the offer of an award by HUD.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:

On June 7, 2011, HUD posted the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for FY2010 Section 3 Program Coordination and Implementation. Today's notice corrects the pages 19-20 of the NOFA application to accurately describe the HUD Policy Priorities activities/outputs and outcomes that must be included in Logic Model (HUD 96010) submissions of potential applicants. As provided by this notice, applicants for funds under the Section 3 Program Coordination and Implementation NOFA must include at least two of the following **Policy Priority activities/outputs** and the related required **outcomes** in their Logic Model, as follows:

Policy Priority #1 Job Creation/Employment. Applicants using this Policy Priority in their Logic Models must include at least one of the following activities/outputs:

“Policy Priority-Job Creation/Employment-Ensure that Section 3 residents are targeted for new employment opportunities”;

“Policy Priority-Job Creation/Employment-Partnership with Workforce Investment Board (WIB) to establish apprentice programs and/or job opportunities”;

“Policy Priority-Job Creation/Employment-Partnerships with local labor unions to Establish Apprenticeship Programs and/or job opportunities”.

The corresponding outcomes must include at least one of the following:

“Policy Priority-Job Creation/Employment-Number of Section 3 Residents Targeted for New Employment Opportunities”;

“Policy Priority-Job Creation/Employment-Number of Section 3 residents hired as a result of targeting efforts”;

“Policy Priority-Job Creation/Employment-Number of career/job training programs offered as a result of partnership(s) with Workforce Investment Board” ;

“Policy Priority-Job Creation/Employment-Number of Section 3 residents hired as a result of partnerships with the Workforce Investment Board”;

“Policy Priority-Job Creation/Employment-Number of apprenticeship programs or job opportunities created as a result of partnership(s) with local labor unions”;

Policy Priority-Job Creation/Employment-Number of Section 3 residents enrolled in apprenticeship programs or hired as a result of partnerships with local labor unions.

Policy Priority #4. Knowledge Sharing and Capacity Building. Applicants using this Policy Priority in their Logic Models must include at least one of the following activities/ outputs:

“Policy Priority-Knowledge Sharing and Capacity Building-Established Partnerships with Local Recipients of HUD Funding or Other Community Partners”;

“Policy Priority-Knowledge Sharing and Capacity Building-Meet with Local Recipients of HUD Funding or Other Community Partners”.

The corresponding outcomes must include at least one of the following:

“Policy-Priority-Capacity Building and Knowledge Sharing-Number of New Supportive Service Partnerships Established”;

“Policy-Priority-Capacity Building and Knowledge Sharing-Number of New Supportive Service Partners Providing Services”;

“Policy-Priority-Capacity Building and Knowledge Sharing-Section 3 Residents- Number of Education/Training Partnerships Established”;

“Policy-Priority-Capacity Building and Knowledge Sharing-Section 3 Residents- Number of Employment/Job Placement Opportunities Created”;

“Policy-Priority-Capacity Building and Knowledge Sharing-Section 3 Businesses-Number of Business Development Partnerships Established; or

Policy Priority-Capacity Building and Knowledge Sharing-Section 3 Businesses- Number of Business Development Opportunities Created.

There are no other modifications to this NOFA.
