**Notice of Amendment and Technical Correction to the Notice Funding Availability for HUD's Fiscal Year (FY) 2011 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program and Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program**

**AGENCY:** Office of Healthy Homes and Lead Hazard Control, HUD.

**ACTION:** Amendment and Technical Correction to the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for HUD's Fiscal Year (FY) 2011 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program and Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program: FR-5500-N-02C

**SUMMARY:** On April 8, 2011, HUD published the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2011 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program and Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program. At that time, the available funding for these programs was unknown since enactment of the FY2011 HUD appropriations had not been completed. On April 15, 2011, the Department of Defense and Full-Year Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011 (Public Law 112-10) was approved and provided the funding for the Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) FY2011 programs. This notice modifies the total available funding for these programs and the maximum amount of each grant award.

Based on the enactment of the FY2011 HUD appropriations, approximately \$95.5 million is available for the programs included in this NOFA. Of this amount, approximately \$47.5 million is available for the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program and \$48 million for the Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program. Of the amount available under the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program, HUD will award a grant for \$3,100,000 in fiscal year 2011 funds to the City of Providence, 400 Westminster Street, Providence, RI 02903-3222, to resolve an issue of eligibility under the fiscal year 2010 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program NOFA.

This Notice also deletes all references that indicate the amount of funds is subject to enactment of FY2011 Appropriations or changes that may occur as a result.

This Notice also amends the deadline date to June 10, 2011

There are no other modifications to this NOFA.

**Deadline Date:** The deadline date is amended to 11.59.59 p.m. on June 10, 2011.

### **I. Amendment to Total Available Funds**

On April 8, 2011, HUD published the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2011 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program and Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program. Under the heading “summary” on page 1; under the heading “available funds” at page 3 Section G.2 of the Overview Information; under the heading “program description” on page 3, Section I.A.1 of the Full Announcement; and at page 6, Section II.A, HUD stated that the available funding is subject to enactment of the FY2011 HUD appropriations.

Based on the enactment of the FY2011 HUD appropriations, approximately \$95.5 million is available for the programs included in this NOFA. Of this amount, approximately \$47.5 million is available for the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program and \$48 million for the Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program. Of the amount available under the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program, HUD will award a grant for \$3,100,000 in fiscal year 2011 funds to the City of Providence, 400 Westminster Street, Providence, RI 02903-3222, to resolve an issue of eligibility under the fiscal year 2010 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program NOFA.

### **II. Amendments to the Maximum Amount of each Grant Award and to the Maximum Amount for the Promotion of Healthy Homes Programs**

Based on the enactment of the FY2011 HUD appropriations, the maximum amount of each grant award and the additional amount available for promotion of healthy homes programs, at page 4, Section I.B.3; at page 5, Section I.B.6; at page 6, Section II.A.1; at page 6, Section II.A.2; and at page 32, Section V.A.3.d line 1, are being amended consistent with the amounts set forth in the following chart:

### **III. Amendments to the Funds Available to New Applicants**

Based on the enactment of the FY2011 HUD appropriations, the maximum amount of funds available to new applicants at page 4, Section I.B.1, is being amended as follows:

“Up to \$4 million would be available under the LBPHC Grant Program for qualified new applicants, i.e., those that have never before received funding from the Office of Healthy Homes and Lead Hazard Control (OHHLHC) under the LBPHC Grant Program or LHRD Grant Program as the primary grantee (note that a new applicant may have been a subgrantee).”

### **IV. Amendment to the Deadline Date.**

The following sections are revised to reflect the amended deadline date of June 10, 2011:

Page 1, Application Receipt Deadline Date, is amended to read: “The application deadline is 11:59:59 p.m. eastern time on **June 10, 2011.**”

Page 2, F.1., Deadline Date: is amended to read: “The application deadline is 11:59:59 p.m. eastern time on **June 10, 2011.**”

Page 21, IV.C.1. Application Deadline is amended to read: “The application deadline is 11:59:59 p.m. eastern time on **June 10, 2011.**”

## **V. Technical Correction to the Deadline date for the Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration (LHRD) Match Waiver Request.**


On page 10, Section B. 2., the Deadline date for the LHRD match waiver request is changed to read: “The request for the LHRD match waiver, with supporting narrative and documentation, must be submitted to Michelle.M.Miller@HUD.gov by the LHRD match waiver request deadline, 5:00 PM eastern time May 16, 2011, which is significantly earlier than the application deadline of 11:59:59 p.m. eastern time June 10, 2011.”

On page 21, Section IV.B.1.b.(6). (f). is changed to read “Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program match waiver request and HUD approval letter, if applicable note that the waiver request must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. eastern time, May 16, 2011.”
