Notice of Technical Correction to the Notice Funding Availability for HUD's Fiscal Year (FY) 2012 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program and Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program

AGENCY: Office of Healthy Homes and Lead Hazard Control, HUD.

ACTION: Technical Correction to the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for HUD's Fiscal Year (FY) 2012 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program and Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program: FR-5600-N-04.

SUMMARY: On November 28, 2011, HUD published the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2012 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program and Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program. FY2012 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control (LBPHC) Grant Program and Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration (LHRD) Grant Program funding was approved by Appropriations Act, 2012 (Public Law 112-55) for the Department of Housing and Urban Development Appropriations Act. This notice modifies the total number of pages for response to the Rating Factors from 20 to 40 pages.

There are no other modifications to this NOFA.

Deadline Date: The application deadline remains 11:59:59 p.m. eastern time on **January 18, 2012**.

I. Revision to Application Format, Total Number of Pages Allowed

On November 28, 2011, HUD published the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2012 Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program and Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program. Under the heading "**Application Format**" on page 20, under the sub-heading "**Narrative Response**", all references to a page limit of 20 pages are replaced with 40 pages.

The revised text reads:

"b. Narrative Response. The narrative to the Rating Factors is limited to a maximum of 40 pages (excluding appendices, budget forms/narrative, and worksheets) of size 8-1/2 x 11 using a 12-point (minimum) font, double-spaced, with margins not less than 1 inch on all sides. While the 40 page

rating factor response does not include attachments, tables, appendices, and other required forms, the applicant should not rely on excessive appendices to address the rating factors – this information should be clearly described in the rating factor narrative. Applicants should be aware that any narrative information submitted in response to the Rating Factors that exceeds the 40 page limit will not be reviewed.”
