

October 2004, A Month to Remember: \$50 Million in NEW HUD Funding for Oregon

Many grantees who submitted applications under HUD's SuperNOFA (Notice of Funding Availability) in late spring and early summer were rewarded with *nearly \$50 million in NEW HUD funding*, which was announced from late September through the end of October 2004.
