

## Capital Fund Education and Training Community Facilities (CFCF) Program

### FY 2011 Grantee Project Descriptions

**The Brewer Housing Authority** will receive \$2,491,690 to construct a 10,035 square-foot, one-story building on housing authority property. When completed, the facility will provide adult education and job training. Partners identified include the Brewer Adult & Community Education Program, Eastern Maine Community College and the Eastern Maine Development Corporation.

**The Newark Housing Authority** will receive \$5,000,000 to construct a 28,000 square-foot, one-story building on housing authority property. When completed, the facility will provide early childhood education, adult education and job training. Partners identified include Innovative Educational Partners, Essex County College and Newark Beth Israel Medical Center.

**The Northwest Georgia Housing Authority** will receive \$1,662,643 to construct a 10,500 square-foot, one-story building at a site located across the street from an existing housing authority property in Rome, GA. When completed, the facility will provide early childhood education, adult education and job training. Partners identified include Georgia Northwestern Technical College, House of the Child Academy, Polk County School System, Polk Family Connection and Redmond Regional Medical Center.

**The Housing Authority of the City of Tacoma** will receive \$1,881,652 to construct an 8,500 square-foot, two-story building on housing authority property. When completed, the facility will provide early childhood education, adult education and job training. Partners identified include Bates Technical College, Tacoma Goodwill and Tacoma Public Schools.

**The White Plains Housing Authority** will receive \$3,500,000 to construct a 13,500 square-foot, one-story building on housing authority property. When completed, the facility will provide adult education and job training. Partners identified include the City of White Plains Board of Education, the Southern Westchester Board of Cooperative Educational Services and the White Plains Youth Bureau.
