



Fiscal Year 2019 Capital Fund Emergency Safety and Security Awards

Anniston Housing Authority (AL) will receive \$246,198 for security camera systems and lighting at the Glen Addie, Norwood Homes, and Constantine Homes developments to improve security and monitoring.

Housing Authority of the Town of Stratford (CT) will receive \$250,000 for security cameras and software at the Robert F. Kennedy, Raymond E. Baldwin, and Elm Terrace developments to improve security and monitoring.

Housing Authority of Homer (LA) will receive \$246,664 for security cameras, doors, and lighting at the Armory, Hudd, Oil Mill, and Washington developments to improve security and monitoring.

Pittsfield Housing Authority (MA) will receive \$250,000 for security cameras, fencing, card access system, and lighting at the Columbia Arms, Jubilee, and Dower Square developments to improve security and monitoring.
