

**FY 2021 Indian Community Development Block Grant
Funding Opportunity Number: FR-6500-N-23**

State	Project Summaries
AK	The Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium on behalf of the Village of Nanwalek will use the grant (\$725,202) to replace the potable water distribution system in Nanwalek, Alaska. The existing system frequently breaks and leaks excessively.
AK	The Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium on behalf of the Village of Russian Mission will use the grant (\$800,000) to build an access road where a new landfill will be constructed in Russian Mission, Alaska. This will help improve the health and safety of residents by locating the landfill further away from the community.
AK	The Alutiiq Tribe of Old Harbor will use the grant (\$800,000) to build a 5,000 square feet community center and tsunami shelter. It will replace three severely dilapidated structures and be located in a tsunami safety zone. In total, the project is estimated to cost \$4 million.
AK	The Cook Inlet Tribal Council will use the grant (\$800,000) to build a 45,000 square feet facility, which will provide child care services and youth, workforce, and economic development programs in Anchorage, Alaska. In total, the project is expected to cost \$42 million.
AK	The Chuloonawick Native Village will use the grant (\$800,000) to rehabilitate 25 housing units, which will include replacing windows, sewer and water pipes, floors, walls, as well as installing arctic entries.
AK	The Hulsia Village will use the grant (\$648,028) to build one (1) single-family home.
AK	The Native Village of Mary's Igloo will use the grant (\$700,000) to complete phase two of the construction of a community facility. In total, the cost of phases one and two is \$3.1 million.
AK	The Native Village of Napakiak will use the grant (\$800,000) to build a new power distribution system, which will extend power to a new subdivision. Due to erosion caused along the Kuskokwim River, more than 20 residential and community buildings need to be relocated.
AK	The Tribal Government of Saint Paul Island will use the grant (\$800,000) to rehabilitate housing units, which will include replacing roofs, doors, and heating systems.
AK	The Village of Venetie will use the grant (\$600,000) to build two (2) single-family houses. The project will utilize a youth project crew.
AZ	The White Mountain Apache will use the grant (\$2,000,000) to rehabilitate twenty-two (22) low-rent housing units.
CA	The All Mission Indian Housing Authority (La Jolla) will use the grant (\$635,000) to build two (2) new homes.
CA	The All Mission Indian Housing Authority (Torres Martinez) will use the grant (\$635,000) to build two (2) new homes.
CA	The All Mission Indian Housing Authority (Viejas) will use the grant (\$635,000) build two (2) new homes.
CA	The Bear River Band of Rohnerville Rancheria will use the grant (\$686,566) to build two (2) townhome rental units.
CA	The Dry Creek Rancheria Band of Pomo Indians will use the grant (\$800,000) to provide homeownership assistance to low-to-moderate income families.
CA	The North Fork Rancheria of Mono Indians will use the grant (\$800,000) to build an emergency access road to support future housing developments.
CA	The Stewarts Point Rancheria - Kashia Band of Pomo Indians will use the grant (\$800,000) to rehabilitate fifteen (15) homes.
ID	The Coeur d'Alene Tribal Housing Authority will use the grant (\$750,000) to rehabilitate twenty-four (24) housing units.
ID	The Fort Hall Housing Authority will use the grant (\$591,220) to purchase 40 acres of land where new housing units can be built.
ID	The Nez Perce Tribal Housing Authority will use the grant (\$750,000) to rehabilitate thirty eight (38) and two (2) elder housing apartment buildings, and to expand youth services programs.
KS	The Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation will use the grant (\$997,970) to fund an infrastructure rehabilitation project for a recreation trail.
KS	The Sac and Fox Nation of Missouri will use the grant (\$628,000) to rehabilitate 38 housing units.
ME	The Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians will use the grant (\$700,000) to create a community center, which will provide wrap-around services to homeless Tribal members.
MI	The Bay Mills Indian Community will use the grant (\$700,000) to build a Boys and Girls Club building.
MI	The Grand Traverse Band of Ottawa and Chippewa Indians will use the grant (\$700,000) to build water lines for the second phase of the Herkner Road development infrastructure project. The second phase is expected to spur the construction of up to 78 additional housing units.
MN	The Bois Forte Band of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe will use the grant (\$700,000) to build a public facility, which will include public works and a food pantry.
MT	The Chippewa Cree Tribe will use the grant (\$1,200,000) to rehabilitate 32 rental units, which will include installing accessibility ramps for elderly or disabled residents.

MT	The Fort Peck Housing Authority will use the grant (\$1,200,000) to replace the roofs of 49 homes, and rehabilitate the exterior of 25 homes.
MT	The Salish and Kootenai Housing Authority will use the grant (\$1,200,000) to build six (6) single-family homes.
NE	The Northern Ponca Housing Authority will use the grant (\$1,200,000) to rehabilitate 86 rental units and provide down payment assistance to 25 eligible homebuyers.
NE	The Winnebago Tribe of Nebraska will use the grant (\$1,200,000) to build a Boys and Girls Club.
NM	The Jicarilla Apache Housing Authority will use the grant (\$800,000) to build four (4) single-family homes.
NM	The Ohkay Owingeh Housing Authority will use the grant (\$800,000) to build a fourplex housing unit.
NM	The Pueblo of Isleta will use the grant (\$800,000) to build three (3) single-family homes.
NM	The San Felipe Pueblo will use the grant (\$800,000) to build six (6) homes.
NY	The Akwesasne Housing Authority will use the grant (\$603,650) to improve 22 home sites to render them suitable and available for new housing.
OK	The Cherokee Nation will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to build a facility, which will include community rooms and a playground. Funds will also be used to provide meals and cultural activities for Tribal elders and children.
OK	The Chickasaw Nation will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to build a youth community center in Sulphur, Oklahoma.
OK	The Citizen Potawatomi Nation will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to fund the development, expansion, and stabilization of microenterprises, while creating and retaining jobs for low- and moderate-income Native Americans.
OK	The Comanche Nation will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to rehabilitate 30 residential units, which will include repairing bathrooms, roofs, exterior doors, siding, and foundations.
OK	The Kickapoo Tribe of Oklahoma Housing Authority will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to build two (2) four-bedroom homes.
OK	The Modoc Nation will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to build a facility, which will provide mental and health-related services.
OK	The Ottawa Tribe will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to build a public facility, where different services and activities can be held.
OK	The Thlopthlocco Tribal Town will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to build a child development center, which will prioritize children with special needs and children who are experiencing homelessness.
OK	The Tonkawa Tribe will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to build a victim services center.
OK	The Wichita and Affiliated Tribes will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to build five (5) greenhouses and a related processing facility. The project will create seven (7) jobs.
OK	The Wyandotte Nation will use the grant (\$1,000,000) to expand and renovate the Pow Wow Grounds.
OR	The Warm Springs Housing Authority will use the grant (\$750,000) to build two (2) single-family homes and one (1) new duplex to replace homes lost in wildfires.
OR	The Grand Ronde Tribe will use the grant (\$750,000) to design and build a child care center, which will serve twenty seven (27) low-income children.
SD	The Cheyenne River Housing Authority will use the grant (\$1,200,000) to complete interior repairs on 40 rental units to ensure their long-term viability.
SD	The Crow Creek Housing Authority will use the grant (\$1,200,000) to rehabilitate 15 rental units and 14 owner-occupied housing units.
SD	The Lower Brule Housing Authority will use the grant (\$1,200,000) to purchase five (5) single-family manufactured homes.
UT	The Paiute Indian Tribe of Utah will use the grant (\$1,200,000) to renovate the Shivwits Community Center, which provides educational and cultural activities.
WA	The Port Gamble S'Klallam Housing Authority will use the grant (\$750,000) for two purposes. The first purpose is to improve the infrastructure to the Warrior Ridge Apartment complex and the other purpose is to provide a youth services program, which addresses childhood hunger and social isolation related to COVID-19.
WI	The Ho Chunk Nation of Wisconsin will use the grant (\$700,000) to install solar panels on 70 housing units.
WI	The Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians of the Lac du Flambeau Reservation of Wisconsin will use the grant (\$700,000) to expand a drug treatment facility.
WI	The Red Cliff Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians of Wisconsin will use the grant (\$700,000) to clean up and remediate 33 abandoned home sites on trust land to render them suitable and available for new housing.
WY	The Eastern Shoshone Housing Authority will use the grant (\$690,000) to install tankless water heaters in 135 housing units, renovate bathrooms in 35 housing units, and replace aging underground wiring and power meters on 21 housing units.
