AK	Angoon Community Association	\$1,035,000	The Angoon Community Association will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct two (2) single-family homes.
AK	Central Council Tlingit-Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska	\$1,725,000	The Central Council Tlingit-Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska will use their grant (\$1,725,000) to construct three (3) single-family homes. A fourth home will be built if the budget allows.
AK	Craig Tribal Association	\$1,035,000	The Craig Tribal Association will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct a 3,000 square-foot duplex for Tribal elders.
AK	Hughes Village Council	\$1,035,000	The Hughes Village Council will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct a traditional elder and youth community facility to provide social distancing.
AK	Klawock Cooperative Association	\$1,035,000	The Klawock Cooperative Association will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct two (2) single-family homes.
AK	Knik Tribe	\$1,035,000	The Knik Tribe will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to purchase four (4) homes.
AK	Native Village of Fort Yukon	\$1,035,000	The Native Village of Fort Yukon will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to help finance the construction of a 10-unit elder housing complex.
AK	Native Village of Tetlin	\$1,034,972	The Native Village of Tetlin will use their grant (\$1,034,972) to construct four (4) tiny homes, as well as improve the infrastructure necessary to ensure year-round access to Tetlin Road.
AK	Organized Village of Kake	\$1,035,000	The Organized Village of Kake will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct two (2) single-family homes and rehabilitate one (1) home.
AK	Organized Village of Saxman	\$1,035,000	The Organized Village of Saxman will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate approximately 12 single-family homes.
AK	Petersburg Indian Association	\$1,035,000	The Petersburg Indian Association will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct a triplex.
AK	Skagway Traditional Council	\$1,035,000	The Skagway Tribal Council will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate 12 single-family homes.
AK	Wrangell Cooperative Association	\$1,035,000	The Wrangell Cooperative Association will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct two (2) small, energy-efficient homes.

AK	Yakutat Tlingit Tribe	\$1,035,000	The Yakutat Tlingit Tribe will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct two (2) single-family homes.
AZ	Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Housing Association	\$3,450,000	The Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Housing Association will use their grant (\$3,450,000) to build two (2) homes and build roads and infrastructure that will provide access to four villages.
AZ	White Mountain Apache Housing Authority	\$3,450,000	The White Mountain Apache Housing Authority will use their grant (\$3,450,000) to build eight (8) single-family homes.
CA	Bear River Rohnerville	\$797,735	The Bear River Rohnerville will use their grant (\$797,735) to help finance the construction of 18 homes.
CA	Campo Band of Mission Indians	\$1,035,000	The Campo Band of Mission Indians will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate 15 to 20 homes.
CA	Dry Creek Rancheria Band of Pomo Indians	\$1,035,000	The Dry Creek Rancheria Band of Pomo Indians will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct a 4,485 square-foot emergency response center.
CA	Kashia-Stewarts Point	\$1,031,600	The Kashia-Stewarts Point will use their grant (\$1,031,600) to improve the community water system. It will include site testing, groundwater exploration, drilling wells, and connecting new wells to the existing processing and distribution system.
CA	Redwood Valley Little River Band of Pomo Indians	\$1,035,000	The Redwood Valley Little River Band of Pomo Indians will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to purchase two (2) modular housing units.
CA	Tule River Indian Housing Authority	\$1,035,000	The Tule River Indian Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate 25 housing units.
ID	Fort Hall Housing Authority	\$1,035,000	The Fort Hall Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate approximately 100 privately-owned homes to improve ventilation, heating, and air-conditioning.

ID	Nez Perce Tribe	\$1,035,000	The Nez Perce Tribe will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to provide increased safety for Tribal inmates by constructing a new adult detention and re-entry center, with expanded capacity to provide social distancing and to address high risk overcrowded and unsafe conditions. The facility will serve as an alternative to state custody where COVID risks have been high.
ME	Houlton Band of Maliseet	\$1,035,000	The Houlton Band of Maliseet will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate a hotel with 11 rooms, which will provide temporary transitional or emergency housing.
MT	Blackfeet Housing Program	\$1,450,000	The Blackfeet Housing Program will use their grant (\$1,450,000) to complete several community projects including rehabilitating a community center, where food and personal protective equipment can be distributed and COVID tests and vaccinations can be administered.
MT	Fort Belknap Tribal Housing Authority	\$1,035,000	The Fort Belknap Tribal Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate 30 homes.
MT	Fort Peck Housing Authority	\$1,725,000	The Fort Peck Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,725,000) to rehabilitate 15 vacant homes and construct one (1) three-bedroom home.
MT	Northern Cheyenne Tribal Housing Authority	\$1,725,000	The Northern Cheyenne Tribal Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,725,000) to make emergency repairs to roughly 248 housing units and install emergency power to the Shoulderblade Elder Complex.
ND	Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa	\$3,290,938	The Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa will use their grant (\$3,290,938) to construct a safe facility for homeless youth, which has been exacerbated by COVID-19.
NE	Omaha Tribe of Nebraska	\$1,035,000	The Omaha Tribe of Nebraska will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct four (4) single-family homes.
NM	Nambe Pueblo Housing Entity	\$1,035,000	The Nambe Pueblo Housing Entity will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate 64 homes, which will include various work including repairing roofs and exterior walls, electrical, furnaces, and windows.
NM	San Felipe Pueblo Housing Authority	\$1,035,000	The San Felipe Pueblo Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate eleven (11) homes to prevent displacement or homelessness.

NM	Zuni Housing Authority	\$1,725,000	The Zuni Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,725,000) to build a new duplex, provide air-purifiers, install streetlights, and provide essential supply delivery to vulnerable families.
OK	Chickasaw Nation	\$3,450,000	The Chickasaw Nation will use their grant (\$3,450,000) to renovate an existing early childhood and head start facility, which serves approximately 160 children. The renovation will include construction of six new classrooms, expansion of the cafeteria/kitchen/dining area to promote social distancing.
OK	Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma	\$3,325,700	The Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma will use their grant (\$3,325,000) to rehabilitate eighty-two (82) housing units, which will include replacing windows, doors, and upgrading HVAC systems to ensure proper air filtration and ventilation systems.
OK	Comanche Nation Housing Authority	\$1,035,000	The Comanche Nation Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate 15 homes, which will include improving ventilation systems and may include adding bedrooms to reduce overcrowding. Additionally, 12 homes will be selected for rehabilitation work including additional bathrooms and bedrooms to reduce overcrowding and facilitate healthy habits.
OK	Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma	\$1,035,000	The Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct a facility to house a food pantry and distribution center.
OK	Ponca Tribe of Oklahoma	\$1,035,000	The Ponca Tribe of Oklahoma will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct eight (8) tiny houses for elders to quarantine and to reduce overcrowding.
OK	Wichita Housing Authority	\$1,035,000	The Wichita Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct two or three duplexes for elders.
OR	Warm Springs Housing Authority	\$1,035,000	The Warm Springs Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate eleven (11) rental units.
SD	Cheyenne River Housing Authority	\$1,725,000	The Cheyenne River Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,725,000) to construct seven (7) rental units.
SD	Sicangu Wicoti Awayankapi Housing Authority	\$3,450,000	The Sicangu Wicoti Awayankapi Housing Authority will use their grant (\$3,450,000) to rehabilitate 23 homes.

SD	Yankton Sioux Housing Authority	\$1,035,000	The Yankton Sioux Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to rehabilitate six (6) relocated homes and two (2) vacant homes.
WA	Lummi Nation Housing Authority	\$1,725,000	The Lummi Nation Housing Authority will use their grant (\$1,725,000) to construct a building with eight (8) one-bedroom housing units.
WA	Muckleshoot Housing Authority	\$963,592	The Muckleshoot Housing Authority will use their grant (\$963,592) to construct two (2) homes.
WA	Squaxin Island Tribe	\$1,035,000	The Squaxin Island Tribe will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct one building with six (6) two-bedroom housing units.
WI	Ho-Chunk Nation	\$1,725,000	The Ho-Chunk Nation will use their grant (\$1,725,000) to provide rental, mortgage, and utility assistance to low-income Tribal members affected by COVID.
WI	Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians	\$1,035,000	The Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians will use their grant (\$1,035,000) to construct a food bank to improve community emergency readiness.
