**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
 BETWEEN THE CITY OF WOONSOCKET
 AND THE SOUTH DAKOTA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE
 REGARDING THE
 COMMUNITY LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

WHEREAS the City of Woonsocket (hereafter known as the applicant) proposes to construct a new Community Library with a Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) which will connect the existing High School and Elementary School buildings; and

WHEREAS the applicant, in consultation with the Office of the South Dakota State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), has determined the High School to be eligible for listing on the National Register of historic Places; and

WHEREAS the applicant, in consultation with the SHPO, has determined that the construction of a new community library addition on the High School (hereafter known as the undertaking) will constitute an adverse; and

WHEREAS the applicant has consulted with the SHPO in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, 16 U.S.C. § 470 (NHPA), and its implementing regulations (36 CFR Part 800.6(b)(1)) to mitigate the adverse effects of the undertaking; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the applicant and the SHPO agree that upon the applicant's decision to proceed with the undertaking, the applicant shall ensure that the following stipulations are implemented in order to mitigate the adverse effects of the undertaking on historic properties, and that these stipulations shall govern the Project and all of its parts until this MOA expires or is terminated.

Stipulations

The City of Woonsocket shall ensure that the following stipulations are implemented:

1. Two sets of Black and White photographs shall be produced. One set shall be submitted to the SHPO for inclusion in the State Archives and one set shall be placed in the New Community Library upon its completion. Photographs shall be produced according to SHPO guidelines; and
2. A brief narrative shall be written to document the school's history; and
3. A historic marker shall be placed at the site.

Execution of this MOA by the Applicant and the SHPO, and its submission to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) in accordance with 36 CFR 800.6(b)(1)(iv), shall, pursuant to 36 CFR 800.6(c), be considered to be an agreement with the Council for the purposes of Section 110(l) of NHPA. Execution and submission of this MOA, and implementation of its terms evidence that the Applicant has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the undertaking and its adverse effects on historic properties, and that the Applicant has taken into account the effects of the Project on historic properties.

Failure to complete the requirement of this agreement within one (1) years of the last signature will result in the termination of this agreement.
