

U/Clearfield City, 365 Main St/DBG/ Demo

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
PURSUANT TO 36 CFR 800.6(a)

WHEREAS, Clearfield City has determined that HUD funded demolition (Undertaking) of the property at 36 South Main Street, Clearfield, Utah (Property) eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, will have an effect a historic property, and has consulted with the Utah State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) pursuant to 36 CFR art 800, regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f); and

NOW THEREFORE, Clearfield City and the Utah SHPO agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

STIPULATIONS

1. INTENSIVE LEVEL SURVEY FORM (ILS): An ILS form or National Register form providing **basic historic information** must be completed following instructions provided by the Utah SHPO.
2. PHOTOGRAPHS: Photographs are required for all buildings or structures on the property. An adequate number of professional quality black and white **35mm photos** (4x6 prints with accompanying negatives) to show all exterior elevations (where possible to obtain all elevations), streetscape photograph, detailed photographs of all areas to be impacted by the adverse effect, photographs of exterior and interior architectural trim/decorations shall be submitted. A similar number of **35-millimeter color slides** shall also be submitted. Photographs shall be labeled with address (street and city) and date photograph was taken and keyed to a site plan and floor plan. Slides shall be numbered and the labeling information submitted on a separate sheet of paper. All prints, negatives and slides shall be submitted in archivally stable protective storage pages.
3. DRAWINGS: **Schematic drawing** of the building's floor plan shall be submitted. The footprint of the building should be accurately measured. Rooms should be labeled by use.
4. RESEARCH MATERIALS: A legible photocopy of the entire **historic tax card** of the property and a **5x7 inch black and white, 35mm print, and negative of the historic tax photo** shall be submitted. Label and submit print and negative as described above. Photocopies of all other research notes must also be submitted.
5. REPOSITORY. All materials shall be submitted to the Division of State History, Historic Preservation Office, to be placed on file.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement by Clearfield City and the Utah SHPO, its subsequent acceptance by the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, and implementation of its terms, evidences that Clearfield City has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the undertaking and its effect on historic properties, and that Clearfield City has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic properties.
